Additionally, all IDSE majors must obtain passing scores on Praxis Core and II and the VCLA. Students are not allowed to take additional courses during the Early Field Exp. and student teaching semesters. Students can have no more than 6 hours of concentration courses to complete after student teaching. All other course work must be completed prior to entering the early field experience.
