Transferring into the Nutrition and Dietetics Program

Admission to upper-level (junior and senior) classes is restricted to students who have met specific application requirements:

- A completed electronic application available through the College of Education and Human Development (CEHD) Academic Advising Center;
- An overall GPA from all colleges attended of 3.0 or above on a 4.0 scale; and
- A grade of C or better in specific prerequisite courses listed below.
