Admissions Policy

In order to apply for admission into the Sports Medicine Concentration, a student must:

1. Have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher from all post secondary schools attended including RU with sophomore standing. Transfer students must complete one semester at Radford prior to admission. **Current GPA** _____
2. Pass the following courses with a “B” or better:
 - BIOL 105, Biology for Health Science: Transfer equivalents and /or substitution courses that can be used as Radford University approved substitutions, will be considered on a case by case basis. **Course and grade** _____
 - BIOL 310 or 322, Human Structures and Function (note: BIO 322 can be used as an entry requirement, but it is not the required course for Sports Medicine majors).
Course and grade _____
 - MATH 137/138 (College Algebra or Precalculus Function Analysis) or higher level math: Transfer equivalents and /or courses that can be used as Radford University approved substitutions, will be considered on a case by case basis.
Course and grade _____
 - PSYC 121, Introductory Psychology: Transfer equivalents and /or courses that can be used as Radford University approved substitutions, will be considered on a case by case basis.
Course and grade _____
 - STAT 200, Introduction to Statistics: Transfer equivalents and /or courses that can be used as Radford University approved substitutions, will be considered on a case by case basis.
Course and grade _____
 - HLTH 200, Wellness Lifestyle: Transfer equivalents and /or courses that can be used as Radford University approved substitutions, will be considered on a case by case basis.
Course and grade _____
3. Have a cumulative math and science GPA of 3.0 (consists of any courses with a Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics or Statistics Prefix. **Current Science GPA** _____)
4. Program Retention: Students must maintain a 3.0 GPA or higher to be retained in the program. Those who fall below a 3.0 for one semester can be removed from the concentration. Only those who show extreme hardship causing the decline in GPA will be retained. This decision will

be made by the concentration faculty and the department chair. Those that drop below a 3.0 for two consecutive semesters will be removed from the concentration regardless of circumstances.

5. Application Procedure: Students must meet the criteria listed above in order to be admitted to upper division courses in the program. Applications and supporting materials are to be submitted by January 31st of the spring semester of the sophomore year or once the student has completed 40 hours – which ever happens first. If January 31st falls on the weekend, then it is due the following Monday. Applications are to be turned into the Department of Health and Human Performance. Students who do not submit a complete application by the deadline will not be allowed to enroll in upper division courses.
