- Jeanne Cox gave everyone a handout regarding Online Student Orientation. This sheet will also be sent to all Graduate Students.
- Nora Reilly was nominated to be chair of the Graduate Affairs Council and was elected by consensus. Paul Witkowsky was nominated as vice chair. Dr. Witkowsky was elected vice-chair by consensus.
- Dr. Reilly asked for volunteers for the standing committees for this year:
   Academic Course and Program Review, Graduate Faculty, Graduate
   College Student Grievance, and Policies & Procedures. Volunteers were asked to indicate themselves as such on the sign-in sheet.
- The Graduate College is moving out of Lucas Hall sometime this year. The Graduate College will eventually move to the Buchanan House.
- Time cards will need to be submitted for all Graduate College supported students. These time cards will need to be submitted to Payroll in Davis 118.

- For any form that can be reasonably fillable, digital signatures may now be used. This process is to help with the legibility of the signatures once the forms are returned to the Graduate College. Dr. Lori Elis demonstrated how simple it is setting up a digital signature. Instructions for creating a signature are available on the Graduate College website. - There will be a graduate research forum held in February, in Charlottesville, to showcase students from around the state. A call will go out shortly.
- The Graduate Student Council would like to be more active this year. They would also like to change the name to "Graduate Dean's Advisory Committee". Student nominations will be accepted from each program to meet with the Dean of the Graduate College at dates to be determined.
- The budget initiative for an increase in GTF work stipends came through in July. The continuous enrollment fee of \$50 has been implemented and placed in the catalog.
- All the internal procedures have been completed for Data Management and now it needs to go to SCHEV.
- A new certificate for "Teaching Language in the Digital Age" will start in Spring, 2014 and has been placed into the catalog.
