Portfolio reviews (ARTG 289 & 489) are listed as 0 credit hour classes. Students must register for portfolio reviews at the same time as their spring courses.

Admissions to the upper level (300-400) graphic design courses is competitive and contingent upon receiving a "C" or better in all required Graphic Design classes and passing the ARTG 289 Program Entry Review.

The graduating senior must pass the ARTG 489 Program Exit Review, which will consist of both a final portfolio review and a Graphic Design exhibition.
