## Guidelines for Behavioral and Biomedical Research

ICMJE<sup>2</sup> recommends authorship be based on the following contributions:

- 1. Substantial contributions to conception and design of the work; or acquisition, analysis, and interpretation of data; *and*
- 2. Drafting the manuscript or revising it critically for important intellectual content; and
- 3. Final approval of the version to be published; and
- 4. Agreement to be accountable for all aspects of the work and ensuring that any questions regarding accuracy or integrity of the work are investigated and resolved.

<u>All 4 conditions must be met for authorship to be granted</u>. Acquisition of funding; data collection, management, or coding; or general supervision of the research group, by themselves, do not justify authorship.
