3. Guest Speaker: Stephanie Jennelle, Associate VP for Finance and University Controller, regarding the Free Expression Policy
 - University is still very deliberate in its philosophy of celebrating the right to freedom of expression on university property.
 - Based on recent events on college campuses, various policies were reviewed to determine if any changes were necessary.
 - Revisions are being made to put safeguards in place to make sure that activities are taken place in a safe and secure environment.
 - Within the Free Expression Policy, there are 2 major groups identified as unaffiliated entities and affiliated entities. Advance notification of spontaneous expression by affiliated entities is not required, all other affiliated entities and sponsored unaffiliated entities are required to provide 48-hour notice. Unaffiliated entities must be officially sponsored by a university college, department, office or university recognized student club or organization.
 - Spontaneous Expression: defined as something that is not planned (recent event in the news occurred); something that has happened within 48 hours and is not planned more than 24-hours in advance; can take place in open generally accessible outdoor areas and should involve less than 10 persons.
 - Campus communication regarding this policy will be sent out for comment. Please check emails for details.
 - Advance notification will be provided to the University Scheduling Department/Office located in Heth Hall
