Ed Oakes stated that alumni email will be migrated to live.edu. The old email addresses will have an auto response telling the sender the new email address.

Ed said that there would be a Clean Access upgrade in January. January was chosen so there won't be an interruption during exams if something should go wrong.

Jackie McNabb announced that Mobile Apps will be coming in January. The Mobile Apps are currently being test by a group of students.

Ed discussed automatic locking of inactive computers. To comply with state and RU security guidelines, DoIT will be updating the security configuration for all faculty and staff Windows computers so they will automatically lock the computer after 30 minutes of inactivity.
