The Information Technology Advisory Committee was called to order by Santhosh Parameswaran at 3:05 pm on March 28, 2014 in Heth Hall 045. Santhosh asked for a motion to approve minutes from the previous meeting on February 28th, 2014. Chad Reed motioned, Adrian Aron seconded, motion carried.

Bill Abplanalp discussed the maximum password age for faculty/staff. He stated that there would be a maximum of 180 days to change passwords, which will fall more in sync with school terms. The targeted implementation for this new password change requirement is the end of September 2014. An email will be sent to all faculty and staff before the implementation.

Ed Oakes stated that IT has received a lot of requests for video streaming classes. Video streaming in the past has had problems with large files being slow and/or locking up. A solution for these problems is a new system called Kaltura. Charles Cosmato, Don Hall, and Lisa McDaniel have been testing Kaltura and are hoping it will be ready for use by Our Turn in May.

Ed announced that Microsoft has released Microsoft Office for iPads. DoIT is checking on the licensing costs for RU and will report back to the committee.

Charles Cosmato motioned to adjourn, Chad Reed seconded the motion. The meeting adjourned at 3:15 pm.
