- September 14-15, 2017 Budget to Board of Visitors for Approval

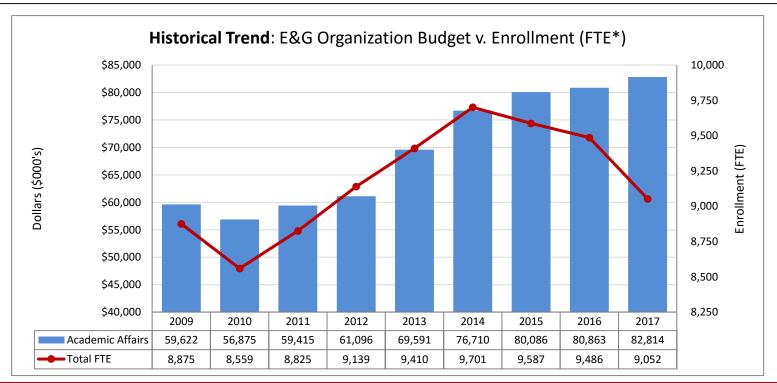

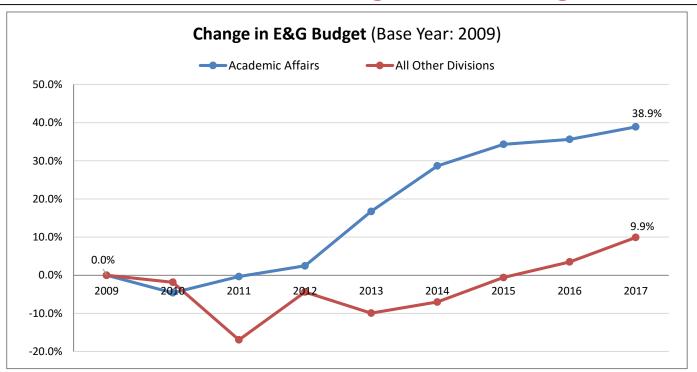

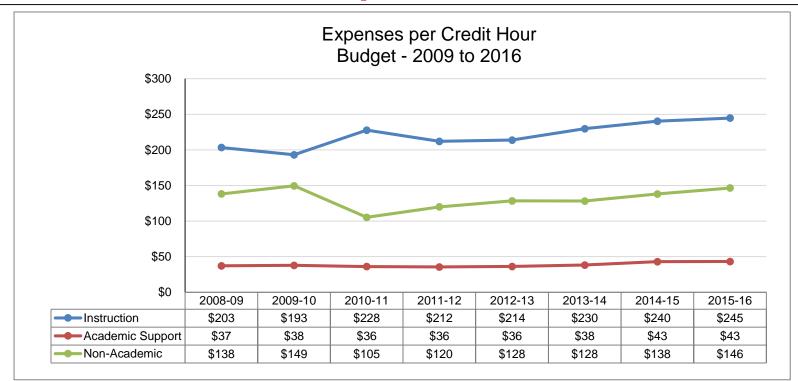
## Historical Trend: Budget vs. Enrollment
