

# Core Staffing Report

## Executive Summary

The attached charts represent the Core Curriculum sections taught by instructors of various ranks since Fall 2010. The charts are organized by the number of sections, not the number of instructors. Because the numbers include the same person teaching over multiple semesters, promotions from assistant professor to associate and from associate to full professor may be included. In addition, the numbers include the same person teaching multiple Core courses in the same semester as well as across semesters. For instance, Laurie Cubbison, associate professor, taught Core 103 and Core 201 in Fall 2011, and Core 103 and 202, in spring 2012. In addition, a few adjunct instructors are teaching at both the 100 level and the 200 level.

The Core A courses are offered in a sequence, with the majority of sections of Core 101 and 201 offered in the fall, and the majority of Core 102 and 202 sections offered in the spring. A small number of sections are offered in the opposing semester for students who are out of sequence.

The part-time faculty section is split into three categories. The largest category is made up of adjunct faculty. Some of these instructors have appointments in another discipline such as art, communication, philosophy or English, among others, as well as the Core Curriculum, while others have been hired specifically to teach in the Core Curriculum. These instructors include graduates of Radford University graduate programs, doctoral students at Virginia Tech, local school teachers, and retired faculty from Virginia Tech. Some of these instructors teach as many as four sections per semester while others teach only one, and those who teach four do so multiple semesters in a row. The second category is made up of administrative/professional faculty at Radford University who teach a Core 201 or 202 course on an adjunct basis in addition to their regular duties. The remaining category contains graduate teaching assistants in the English Department mentoring program who teach Core 101 and 102 under the supervision of their faculty mentors, a program in existence since the mid-1980s.
